

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY AND BEACH QUALITY

Lloret de Mar Town Council has adopted the commitment to manage the beaches, trying to meet the expectations of users and beyond this, offering installations and services that are good quality, comfortable, adapted to the needs of society, with the greatest respect for the environment and trying to preserve the natural resources, thus contributing to the sustainable development of the town.

Lloret Town Council's lines of action to be able to meet this challenge are summarised in the following principles:

- To assign the necessary resources to introduce and keep operative an integrated management system that guarantees the continuous improvement of the environmental behaviour on the beaches in the municipality and of the services provided on them, with the definition of environmental and quality objectives and goals, that will be periodically reviewed and updated by the relevant responsible people.
- To comply with applicable legislation and, on our own initiative and for social responsibility reasons, the requisites voluntarily agreed on by the town council, which may have a favourable repercussion on the quality of the services offered and on the environment.
- To guarantee the rational use of natural resources and to prevent pollution, through the application of programmes and the introduction of work guidelines and the measures necessary to reduce the direct and indirect environmental effects created and to minimise the environmental and associated health and hygiene risks, as far as possible, also bearing in mind exceptional or emergency cases.
- To favour internal and external communication with criteria of transparency and to promote the training and creation of awareness of all the agents involved in the management of beaches, in matters concerning safety, health, quality, environment and user satisfaction.
- To transfer the local corporation's strategic principles to contractors and suppliers and to encourage them to introduce them, as well as disseminating and placing at the availability of the general public the main principles of the environmental management and municipal quality.

The coast is a common asset, therefore from the Town Council, we would like to involve all the users and everyone who carries out their activities on the beaches in this project, promoting their collaboration in the protection and improvement of the Lloret coast and seeking the satisfaction of everyone who, in some way or another, enjoys these places.
